

## Georgetown County Detention Center Technology Replacement



**FY 2010 REQUEST:** \$ 1,600,000

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**OVERVIEW:** Georgetown County's current detention center facility was constructed in 1994. At the time the facility included "state-of-the-art" technology. Over the years the original equipment has begun to fail with most items now obsolete. As a result equipment parts are becoming increasingly difficult to obtain and many systems are rapidly becoming un-repairable.

### **THE NEED:**

All computer and technology based systems within the facility are in need of improvement in order to insure the security and safety of staff and inmates at within this facility.

### **PROPOSED SOLUTION:**

Acquisition and installation of the following equipment:

Management System Touch Screen / Joystick driven monitors for control center PCs

Management PCs and Servers to provide access management for lights, cell doors, intercom systems within cells and management areas, interior and exterior doors, gates and video surveillance

Gateway switches for controlling access and video systems

Wiring for network, intercoms, lighting, door access, cameras, PCs and telephones

Various applicable software licenses for access and surveillance security systems

### **PROJECTED RESULTS:**

Technology advancements over the past 12+ years since this facility was constructed have rendered existing systems obsolete. Acquisition and installation of the modern security, surveillance and communication systems as outlined above for this 156 bed detention facility will provide immediate life safety improvements to both inmates and staff members housed and working within this detention facility.
